


These instructions will guide you through setting up your cloud DVR for remote access.

1. Connect your DVR to the network.
2. Create an account.
 - a. Open a web browser and navigate to www.onviewcloud.net.
 - b. Find the blue **Register** link on the landing page and click on it.

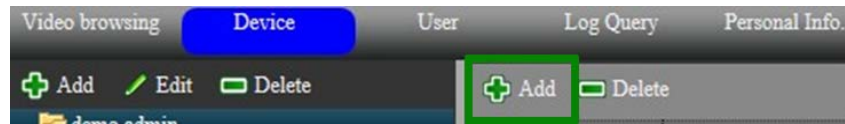


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- c. Fill in your registration information (see below the image).

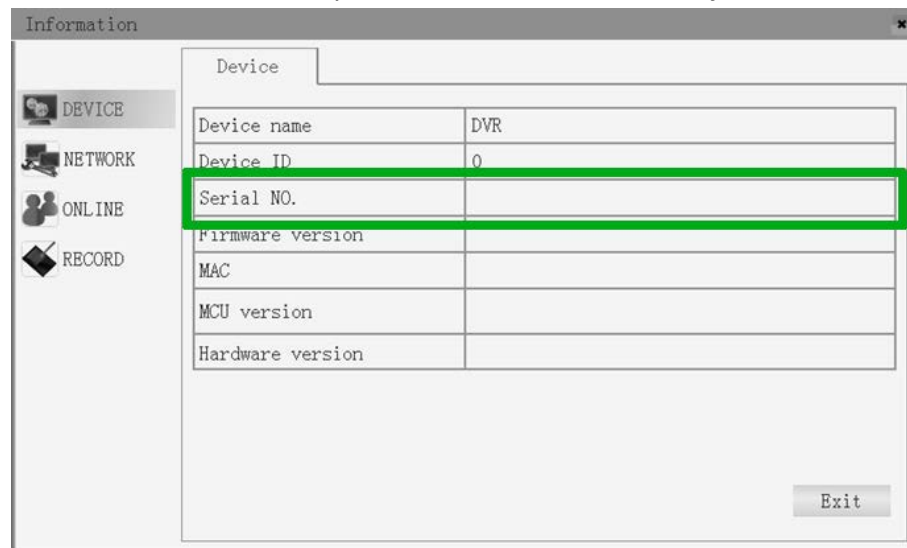


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- i. Make up a user name to use as your account.
- ii. Make up a password for your account.
- iii. Skip the Name and Telephone fields. They are unnecessary.

- iv. Enter a valid email address into the Email field. This email account will be used for password recovery if you ever forget your password.
 - v. Click the **Register** button to create your new account.
 - vi. Click *OK* and log in to your new account.
3. Add a DVR to your www.onviewcloud.net account.
- a. Click on *Device* in the top menu bar.
 - b. Click the green plus sign next to *Add* on the right.



- c. Fill in the DVR information
 - i. **Device name:** make up something descriptive, like *West Coast Shop #1*.
 - ii. **Serial Number:** find this in your DVR's *Main Menu* under *Information*.



- iii. **Device user:** the user name that came with your DVR (unless you changed it).
 - Default: admin
 - iv. **Device password:** the password that came with your DVR (unless you changed it)
 - Default: <no password>
4. Access your DVR
- a. Download and install *PCMS* from our website or from our FTP server.
 - i. <ftp://108.47.57.99/A-Series/>
 - ii. User name: software
 - iii. Password: download
 - b. Enter your login information (from the account you created in Step 2).
 - c. Double-click on the green icon beside the name of the DVR you want to access.
5. Video Playback
- a. Click on *Playback* (below *Live View* on the right) to access the playback user interface.
 - b. Double-click on the DVR you want to access.

- c. Select the date and channels you want to search through.
 - d. Press the play button to begin video playback.
 - Red lines indicate motion was detected and recorded.
 - Green lines indicate video was recorded automatically.
6. Configure your DVRs settings
- a. Click on *Remote Settings* (below *System Settings*).
 - b. Adjust the DVR settings according to your requirements.
